Each participant is expected to present and discuss their **work-in-progress** on topics including but not limited to:

- Empirical approaches to modern translation history
- Synergies of sociology and history of translation
- Extraliterary factors in global literary circulation
- Translation and global literary studies
- Digital approaches to translation history
- Bridging the gap between macro and micro perspectives in historical and sociological research into translation

To foster friendly and interactive environment, the event is open to presenting participants only.

Each paper shall include a) research rationale, b) research hypotheses and questions, c) methodology, d) data presentation, e) preliminary results (if available), e) research issues for discussion.

Presentation time limit: 20 minutes (shorter presentations preferred).

Discussion time limit: none.

Working language: English

Participation is free of charge.
